October Newsletter Trivia answers

One of the amazing things of our country is that we are formed from many different traditions and culture, with this we have adopted several mixed traditions for the Holydays. Please mention a few of them and where they are from;

1.- What does a candle on a window means, and where did the tradition originated?

The candle was often placed in the window when a member of the family was away. The lit candle was also placed in the window as a sign of good news or as a beacon to weary travelers. Candles also represented friendship and were seen as a sign of welcome to others. And Started in England

2.- When did we saw the first Christmas tree in America and who is credit it for the tradition?

Most 19th-century Americans found Christmas trees an oddity. The first record of one being on display was in the 1830s by the German settlers of Pennsylvania, although trees had been a tradition in many German homes much earlier. The Pennsylvania German settlements had community trees as early as 1747. But, as late as the 1840s Christmas trees were seen as pagan symbols and not accepted by most Americans.
